LEVEL 6: Fundamentals of CEREC and GALILEOS Integration

CEREC MASTERY - RAPID INTEGRATION INTO YOUR PRACTICE WITH 4.0 SOFTWARE

Level 2 is **NOT** a replacement for Basic Training, which is a prerequisite for this course. Whereas Basic Training through your local Patterson branch concentrates on one design technique (Biogeneric) on single teeth, Level 2 teaches all available design techniques on multiple units. This redesigned course teaches all you need to know about 4.0.

LEVEL 2 IS RECOMMENDED FOR DOCTORS WHO:

- Cannot consistently finish a restoration in 90 minutes or less
- Are not familiar with all the software tools and menus in 4.0
- Do not consistently understand the differences in the different design modes
- Do not thoroughly understand what Parameters are
- Do not realize the concept of preparation design with the CEREC
- Do not understand the concept of overmilling and the different milling modes
- Are not using their machines to the fullest capacity
- Wish to completely understand the fundamentals of CEREC dentistry
- Wish to thoroughly understand the fundamentals of stain and glaze

LEVEL 3

POSTERIOR QUADRANT PROFICIENCY AND RESTORING IMPLANTS

If you **FULLY** understand parameters, preparation design, the basics of software design and the milling concepts of the milling unit, consider Level 3. In this course, little time will be spent time on the fundamentals – we assume you already know these. The course will delve right into advanced design techniques and show you how to efficiently leverage your prep and mill time by doing efficient quadrants, as well as how to properly restore implants.

RECOMMENDED FOR DOCTORS WHO:

- Have a basic understanding of the different design tools and want to take their knowledge to a deeper level
- Understand the basics and would like to comprehend principles as they apply to clinical practice
- Want to increase efficiency by learning different quadrant techniques
- Would like to discover all the tips and techniques the software is capable of beyond single-tooth restoration
- Want to learn multiple ways to restore implants with temporary and final restorations – both cement and screw-retained
- Understand the tools and menus of the software, but wish to delve deeper into more advanced concepts

Note - It is recommended that clinicians have completed at least 100 units prior to attending Level 3. If you have completed less than 100 units, start with Level 2.

LEVEL 4

MASTERING MULTIPLE CEREC ANTERIORS

Once you have mastered the basic and advanced techniques taught in Levels 2 and 3, and want to test and expand your knowledge, consider the Level 4 course. Level 4 is intended for those doctors who have completed the previous levels and want to apply the knowledge to go deeper with the CEREC and utilize the machine for larger cases.

INTENDED FOR DOCTORS WHO:

- Want to expand upon the techniques learned in Levels 2 and 3
- Wish to learn additional techniques to treat multiple teeth
- Are ready to learn to perform multi-unit anterior cases in a single visit
- Wish to master treating anterior teeth with the CEREC, whether single or multiple units

Note - Completion of Levels 2 and 3 is strongly recommended prior to attending level 4

LEVEL 5

CEREC INLAB PROFICIENCY AND MASTERY ESTHETICS

This two-day course combines both lecture and hands-on, and will give doctors advanced capabilities that are not possible with the chairside software. Doctors will also receive extensive hands-on experience with manipulating porcelain and performing advanced cutback and stain and glaze techniques.

INTENDED FOR DOCTORS WHO:

- Want to increase their knowledge of the inLab software
- Want to improve their ability to manipulate porcelain
- Already have the CEREC system
- Have completed the core CEREC training curriculum at Scottsdale Center

LEVEL 6

Learn the basics of implant placement using the guided protocol, and the advantages and disadvantages of each surgical system. There are no prerequisite for Level 6.
